INTRAMURAL SPORTS
Football Pick 'Em

Entry:

1. There is no entry fee for Football Pick 'Em. Entrants must fill out an Individual Entry Card at the Members Services desk, making sure to give their name, email address and phone number.

Rules:

1. Entrants will be emailed an excel document of 20 games from the NCAA and NFL schedules. (Participants should make sure their computer supports excel files.)
2. The games document for each week will be emailed out on Tuesday of that week. Participants must complete the form and email back the document by **THURSDAY at 5pm**. Any form received after the 5pm deadline will not be counted.
3. For each game a winner should be picked by placing an 'X' next to that team.
4. After a winner is picked for each game, confidence points should then be placed next to each game.
5. Confidence points range from 1-20, with 1 being the "least confident" and 20 being the "most confident."
 - a. All games must be ranked. Any game that is not ranked will be given a confidence rating of 1.
 - b. All 20 confidence values must be used. Therefore no two games should have the same confidence ranking. In the event that two games are ranked with the same confidence value, both games' rankings will be reduced to 1 point each.
6. Each week there will also be a tie breaker question. Participants should also answer this question as it will be used in the event of a tie for 1st place.

Winners:

1. A weekly winner will be announced based on the scores from that week's games. These winners will be given an old Intramural Champion t-shirt. In the event of a tie, the tie breaker question will be used. If there is still a tie, then the individual who correctly picked the most winners will be declare the winner. If there is a still a tie, then that week there will be two winners.

2. An overall winner will be announced at the conclusion of the 10 week competition, based on the total amount of points accumulated from the entire competition. In the event of a tie, the individual with the most correct games picked will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, then there will be two winners. The overall winner will receive a current Intramural Champion t-shirt.
3. One winner will also be determined by the NCAA Bowl Game Challenge. When the bowl game announcements have all been made, a final pick 'em sheet will go out to all participants. The individual with the most points will also win a current Intramural Champion t-shirt. The 10 week competition results have no bearing on the Bowl Game Challenge.

Season:

1. The 10 Week competition will begin on September 11th and go through November 15th.
2. The NCAA Bowl Game Challenge will begin on Dec. 18th (New Mexico Bowl) and end on Jan. 10th 2011 (BCS National Championship).
