Responsibilities

Typical job duties include but are not limited to:

- Design graphics for use in print media. Examples include banners, fliers, brochures, ads in local magazines and newspapers, and more.
- Assist with the creation of digital images and advertisements for publication on the internet, RecTV, and social media.
- Maintain a library of images to be used in marketing collateral.
- Assist with photography of Rec Sports classes, events, drop-in recreation, and facilities.
- Assist with special projects and office duties as necessary.

Experience and Abilities

Required experience and abilities include:

- Graphic layout and design experience.
- Proficiency using InDesign, Photoshop, Illustrator, and other Adobe software applications.
- Experience color-correcting and retouching images.
- Creativity and a good eye for design.
- Photography experience preferred.
- Strong attention to detail.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.

A portfolio of previous design work is required with application.

Additional Information

This position is available to students only. Work schedules are flexible; however, applicants must be able to work 12-15 hours per week. Summer availability is required.
